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## Ribbon Shapes Instructions

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### Instructions:

1. Fold the Whisper White Cardstock in half with a Bone Folder.
2. Adhere the Chocolate Chip Cardstock to the card with SNAIL Adhesive.
3. Run the Crumb Cake Cardstock through the Big Shot with the tree, candy cane and gingerbread man framelits laid out on the cardstock, evenly spaced and not too close to the edges.
4. Apply SNAIL Adhesive around each of the shapes and lay the ribbon across the backs of each of the cut outs and into the adhesive. Work from the long piece of ribbon and cut as you go to the length needed. Be sure to pull the ribbon taught so that it lies nicely on the card.
5. Wrap the Early Espresso Baker's Twine around the cardstock bottom twice and tie in a bow.
6. Adhere Crumb Cake Cardstock to the card with SNAIL Adhesive.
7. Stamp "merry" in Real Red Ink on Whisper White Cardstock Scrap and punch out with the Little Labels Punch.
8. Punch out a little hole on side of label and loop into bow. OR to make things a bit easier...adhere under Baker's Twine bow with SNAIL Adhesive.
