
Faux Etched Glass & Rhinestone Dying Instructions

Instructions:

1. Fold the Tempting Turquoise Cardstock in half with the Bone Folder.
2. Adhere the Basic Black Cardstock to the card with SNAIL Adhesive.
3. Adhere the Whisper White Cardstock to the card with

SNAIL Adhesive.

4. Punch out 4 square punch outs with the 1 3/8" Square Punch.

5. Round 2 kiddy corners of each square with the Corner Rounder Punch - adhere the squares to the card with SNAIL Adhesive.

6. Stamp "thanks big time" in Jet Black StazOn Ink on the Whisper White Cardstock - dove tail the right end of the cardstock and then adhere strip to the card with Stampin' Dimensionals.

7. Stamp the blossom image in VersaMark Ink on Vellum Cardstock and Heat Emboss with White Embossing Powder - punch out with Blossom Punch and adhere to card with Stampin' Dimensionals.
8. Punch out a Tempting Turquoise Polka Dot $\frac{3}{4}$ " Circle and adhere it to the card with SNAIL Adhesive.
9. Color a Rhinestone Jewel with a Black Sharpie while still on the wax paper, then stick it to the flower.
